

CITY TRUNK LINE SOUTH UNIT 4 PROJECT

City Trunk Line South-Unit 4 Project Overview

The City Trunk Line South-Unit 4 project is an important water infrastructure investment and will replace a portion of trunk line installed in 1914, which has a history of leaks and breaks. The new steel trunk line, which will be 36, 54 or 60 inches in diameter across a length of approximately 9,000-foot (1.7 miles), will be necessary to withstand the higher pressures expected in the system in the future. It will also improve the reliability of LADWP's water distribution system and assist with water quality improvement projects. The trunk line will be constructed utilizing open trench and trenchless pipe jacking methods.

Construction is projected to last into early 2017 along Magnolia Boulevard, Whitsett Avenue and Moorpark Street.

Tentative Construction Schedule

Hours of work will be 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon. through Fri. with some construction occurring on Saturdays. Phase II hours of work may extend until 6:00pm or later.



Traffic Information

Traffic and parking will be impacted. Temporary Tow-away/No Parking signs will be posted as needed. Local and driveway access will be provided.

Phase I Traffic Impacts (Dec. 2015 to Sep. 2016):

- One Southbound lane will be open on Whitsett Avenue.
- Northbound Whitsett Avenue will be closed. A detour is available on Riverside Drive.

Phase II Traffic Impacts:

- Jul. 2015 to Jul. 2016-Magnolia Boulevard will have one lane open in each direction.
- Jul. 2015 to Sept. 2016-Whitsett Avenue will have one Southbound lane open. The Northbound lane north of Riverside Drive will be closed. A detour will be available on Riverside Drive.
- Oct. 2016 to Feb. 2017-Whitsett Avenue will have one lane open in each direction.
