Subject: City Trunk Line South – Unit 4 (CTLS-4) Project Phase 1 – Construction on Whitsett Avenue from Otsego Street to Huston Street

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is currently constructing the CTLS-4 Project. The CTLS-4 Project is one of six units needed to complete the 9-mile City Trunk Line South and will replace a portion of the 1914, 66-inch diameter riveted steel pipeline. The CTLS-4 Project Phase 1 consists of installing approximately 7,200 feet (1.4 miles) of 36-inch, 54-inch, and 60-inch diameter welded-steel water pipeline. The project will improve the water quality and reliability in the San Fernando Valley area, as well as surrounding communities served by the City of Los Angeles.

The current work zone on Whitsett Avenue from Magnolia Boulevard to Otsego Street is scheduled to be restored on Thursday, December 10, 2015, and a new work zone will be implemented on Whitsett Avenue from Otsego Street to Huston Street. Addison Street will be closed to through traffic on the east side of Whitsett Avenue. Construction work in the new work zone is scheduled to be completed in May 2016. Construction will occur Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with the possibility of occasional work on Saturdays. The entire CTLS-4 Project Phase 1 is anticipated to be completed in September 2016.

Traffic on this new work zone will be restricted to only one lane southbound on Whitsett Avenue from Otsego Street to Huston Street, with northbound lanes closed to through traffic. Northbound traffic lanes will be detoured at Riverside Drive for northbound commuters (see detour map). Local access will be provided. This is the second of three work zones on Whitsett Avenue between Magnolia Boulevard and Riverside Drive that will have northbound closure to commuters.

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) DASH route going north on Whitsett Avenue will continue to be re-routed through Laurel Canyon Boulevard.

As before mentioned, traffic and parking along Whitsett Avenue will be affected by the construction activities. In order to provide adequate space for construction work and traffic, LADOT will post "Temporary Tow-Away, No Parking" signs on Whitsett Avenue within the work zone. Please follow all posted signs. Vehicles parked in the temporary no-parking zone will be ticketed and towed away.
