Comments from the public on Agenda items will be heard only when the item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the Agenda within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction will be heard during Public Comment. Public comment is limited to 1 minute per speaker, unless waived by the presiding officer of the Board. Agenda is posted for public review on myvalleyvillage.com, the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment website, and at Faith Presbyterian Church, 5000 Colfax Avenue and is sent to NCVV's database of stakeholders.

A second motion may be presented to the NCVV board to provide consent for its logo to be used on Reimagine District NoHo correspondence in the list of community groups who oppose the development as proposed.
