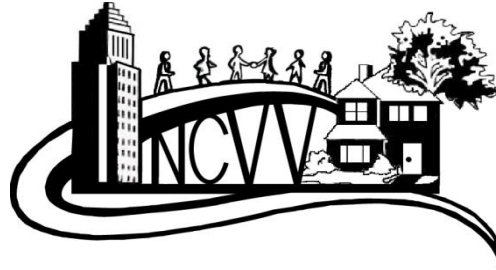

IN CONFORMITY WITH THE SEPTEMBER 16, 2021 ENACTMENT OF CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 361 (RIVAS) AND DUE TO CONCERNS OVER COVID-19, the Neighborhood Council Valley Village meeting will be conducted entirely with a call-in option or internet-based service option. AB 361 Updates - Public comment cannot be required to be submitted in advance of the meeting, only real-time public comment is required. If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned. If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned. Instructions on how to sign up for public comment will be given to listeners at the start of the meeting. *Public comment on the call will be limited to one minute and one comment per item. Zoom requires that any person wishing to comment use \*9 to alert the moderator that they wish to speak.
